The Bosnia and Herzegovina/Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina has received loans for financing from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) and European Investment Bank (EIB) toward the cost of the Federation Road Sector Modernization Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for: Reconstruction of Black spots M-4.2 Mala Lisa, M-17 Mostar jug, M-17 and M6 Čapljina, M-17 Tarčin – Konjic, Construction of slow lane M-5 “Lanište” and Improvements to bridge over the river Bregava M-17 Tasovčići.

This contract will be jointly financed by the European Investment Bank and the World Bank. Bidding process will be governed by the World Bank’s rules and procedures as a National Competitive Bidding (NCB).

1. The JP Ceste Federacije BIH d.o.o., Sarajevo now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for:

Lot 1:

- Reconstruction of Black spot “Mala Lisa” km 11+230 M-4.2 Skokovi – Srbljani
- Construction of slow lane “Mountain Pass Lanište” M-5 Bos. Petrovac - Ključ

Lot 2:

- Improvements to bridge over the river Bregava in Tasovčići M-17
- Reconstruction of Black spot M-17 Tarčin – Konjic km 16+800 – km 17+600
- Reconstruction of Black spot “Mostar jug” km 1+640 M-17
- Reconstruction of Black spot “Kružni tok” M6 and M-17

Lot 3:

- Pavement reconstruction and construction of roundabout “Vitkovići” M20

2. Anticipated period for reconstruction will be:

- Lot 1 - 365 days / 12 months
- Lot 2 - 120 days / 4 months
- Lot 3 - 180 days / 6 months

Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank’s Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers January 2011, revised July 2014 (“Procurement Guidelines”), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.
