

Invitation for Bids

The Bosnia and Herzegovina/Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina has received loans for financing from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) and European Investment Bank (EIB) toward the cost of the Federation Road Sector Modernization Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for Improvements to bridges over rivers: Ljubina; Sana – Ključ; Pliva – Jajce; across deep obstacle Komar; and Vrbas – Bugojno. This contract will be jointly financed by the European Investment Bank and the World Bank. Bidding process will be governed by the World Bank's rules and procedures as an National Competitive Bidding (NCB).

- 1. The JP Ceste Federacije BIH d.o.o., Sarajevo now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for:
- Improvements to Bridge over Ljubina river;
- Improvements to Bridge over Sana river, Ključ;
- Improvements to Bridge over Pliva river, Jajce;
- Improvements to Bridge Komar, across deep obstacle;
- Improvements to Bridge over Vrbas river, Bugojno.

Anticipated period for Improvements will be 180 days in the years 2017/2018 (winter period is excluded).

- 2. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers January 2011, revised July 2014 ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
